This is a wonderful tool to use if you're looking for a qualified, verified respite worker for your family member(s). All types of needs are supported and there are workers located all across Ontario. You simply create your profile, complete the needs checklist, and, should you wish, create a support request detailing your needs, and you will be able to see which support workers in your area are a good match.

In Kaitie's role, she is notified when someone is enrolled, and she can help out whenever you need assistance. You can download the Respite Now app from the Apple App store or Goggle Play store. You can also search respite-now.com. for information.
