Requirements:

This position is advertised under the Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) initiative. To be eligible for this position, you must be between 18 and 29 years of age on the start date of the job. You also must be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, or a refugee under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.

- Some work/volunteer experience supporting people with developmental disabilities, or related work. Experience with adults is an asset.
- Applicants must be available for the entire 9 weeks of employment.
- Vulnerable Sector Police Clearance issued by a local police station no more than 6 months old or willing to obtain one.
- First Aid/CPR certified or a willingness to obtain certification.
